The intimate, speakeasy-style 650-capacity concert venue showcases exposed brick, high industrial ceilings, hardwood floors, and dark walls designed for classified rocking. Of course, that intimacy also affords an up-close peek at your favorite rockers' tats, track marks, and other Twitter-worthy goodness.

HDTV screens project images and video on both sides of the raised center stage, while an elevated VIP section with leather banquettes and a private bar calls you from above.

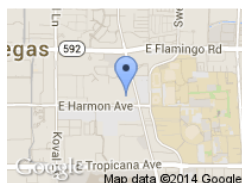
